

# Philip Nuttall

1886 - 1967

Philip was born in **1886**. He was baptised on 29<sup>th</sup> November 1896 at **St Matthew**, Mount Street, Little Bolton in the presence of his father Thomas William and his mother Annie Maria. They were living at 60 Arkwright Street, (off Chorley New Road) in Horwich. His father is described as a cashier.<sup>1</sup>



Philip is recorded in the 1901 Census as still living at 60 Arkwright Street. His father (aged 40) still works as a cashier but now shown as working in a bank. His father was born in Bolton whilst his mother was born in Burslem, Staffordshire. She was 39 years of age. Philip has a sister Ada aged 5 years and he was shown as 4. Ada was also born in Bolton.

The family must have been reasonably well off as they had a servant Ann Edwards working for them – she was 20 years old and shown as a 'General Servant (Domestic)'.

On the 1911 Census the family are living at 18 New Hall Lane, Smithills, Bolton.(close to Chorley Old Road). Father Thomas is now a chief cashier in banking. Philip's parents have been married 17 years and had the two children both of whom appear on the

census as scholars.

Philip married Miriam Silvester on **6 September 1921** at St Peter, Halliwell. He is recorded as a 24 year old 'Salesman' living at 12 Newhall Lane (New Hall Lane). Miriam was 24 years of age. Father Thomas William is present along with the bride's father Joseph Silvester who was a Clerk in Holy Orders. They were married by Percy Stott. Witnesses were Alan Ormrod, Mary Hughes and JW Nuttall.

The Death Index for the quarter **April to June 1967** records the death of Philip Nuttall aged 70 years.

[Only two WW1 Medal Roll Indexes can be found. One for a Philip Nuttall who served in France with the Royal Fusiliers & South Lancashire Regiments as a Private (9108) from 14 April 1916 and who lived at 'Friars Croft', Markland Hill, Bolton and received the Victory and British medal. The other served in the Royal Lancashire Regiment as a private (18837) and was also awarded the Victory and British medals.
